

East Surrey Mixed Indoor League (2nd Amendment) Guidelines Amended March 2023

1. League matches will be 3 rinks and be organised as part of the Club's Match programme for Saturdays, Sundays, or weekdays as is mutually acceptable. Grey trousers with club shirts will be worn. There will be no 'double headers'. The Home Club's match arrangements will be complied with**. All matches must comply with the Surrey CBA time limit of 4 hours after the trial ends.
2. All fixtures will be on a home and away match basis and will receive points as follows:
 - a. 2 points for each winning rink
 - b. 1 point for each drawn rink
 - c. 6 points for winning the game overall on shots difference
 - d. 3 points for a drawn match on shots total.

Total 12 points awarded

If a club cannot fulfil a fixture on the arranged date, all 12 points will be conceded to the opposition. There may be mitigating circumstances for severe weather.

3. Each rink should consist of 2 ladies and 2 men. In the event of any team being short of 2 ladies and 2 men in each rink, the match may proceed even if all rinks are 3 + 1 either way. If these restrictions are met, there will be no deduction of shots or points. If these conditions are not met and a rink consists of all men or all ladies, 25% of the total shots will be deducted from the defaulting rink. If only 3 players play against 4, on one of the rinks, both Leads bowl as normal with 2 bowls each. They are followed by the number 2 on the non-defaulting rink, who bowls both bowls consecutively. The 3's and Skips then bowl as normal with their 2 bowls. There will be no loss of shots.
4. Any dietary requirements must be notified to the home team at least 72 hours in advance.
5. **Each match will be of 2 trial ends and 18 ends.**
6. **The match secretary of each Club will send one copy of the club's fixture list, to the match secretary of each league Club and a copy to Neil Bartlett. Alan Simon must also receive contact details for the person(s) running this League at all member clubs simon.alan1@icloud.com**
7. The Home Club match secretary or Captain will be responsible for advising Alan Simon of any cancellation or re-arrangement of a fixture.
8. The captain of the Home Club will be responsible for sending, by email, a copy of the standard results sheet, not more than 48 hours after playing the match, to:
